#### ISN NETWORLD RAVS PLUS VERIFIED!

Since 2005, numerous ARI/QI clients engaged with a new online contractor safety management platform called ISNetworld. ISN collects health, safety and regulatory information on potential customer contractors allowing their hiring clients to connect with safer, more reliable and sustainable contractors like Asbestos Removal, Inc. and Quality Insulators, Inc.

One of ISN's key components is their "review and verification services", or RAVS. This is a compliance standard use by ISN to determine whether a contractor has the required insurance coverage, safety protocol, and training necessary to be an approved contractor. In addition, ISN recently implemented an audit process called RAVS PLUS to verify a contractor's comprehensive safety program. RAVS PLUS is an audit tool that enables ISN to more accurately determine the validity of answers provided and documentation uploaded into a contractor's account.

In February 2018, both ARI and QI completed the RAVS PLUS verification process. The audit inspected everything from management systems down to field personnel's knowledge of the companies' safety culture, safe practices, and OSHA regulations and standards. Both companies completed the audit with minimal follow up and are now listed as "RAVS Plus Verified" contractors to any and all potential clients seeking our services.
