

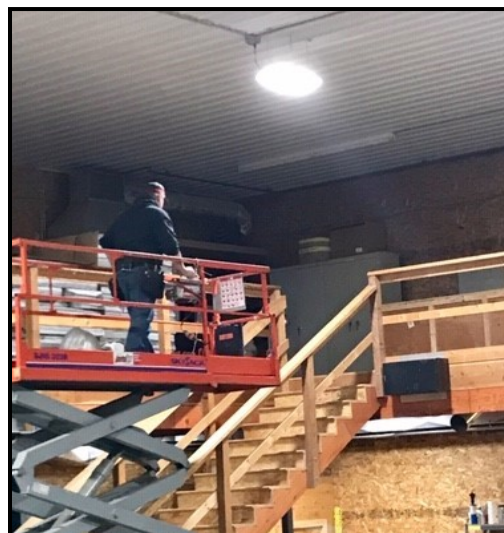
## CONTINUALLY IMPROVE

Several ARI employees successfully completed the course requirements for 8-Hour Lead Safe Renovator Initial Training. This training was provided in September by Milwaukee Lead and Asbestos per EPA Standard 40 CFR Part 745.225. Completion of this course, in addition to certification as a Lead-Safe Company, allows ARI to perform or direct renovation activities in pre-1978 housing and other child-occupied facilities. This includes all activities that disturb lead painted surfaces. Make sure to let us know if you will be doing any repairs, remodeling or maintenance activities that disturbs lead painted surfaces, so we can assist with safe completion of your project.

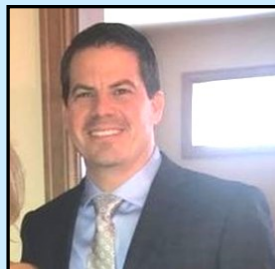
